4.	Lower Status of Barbarism	Begins with pottery and ends with subsistence based on domestic plants and/or animals
5.	Middle Status of Barbarism	Begins in the eastern hemisphere with the domestication of animals
		Begins in the western hemisphere with the cultivation of maize and other plants
		Ends with the process of smelting iron
6.	Upper Status of Barbarism	Begins with iron smelting and ends with the invention of a phonetic alphabet and writing
7.	Civilization	Begins with the invention of a phonetic alphabet and writing
